



BSAMOA Club Touring Rally

Le Tour de BSA 3 (Trois)

November 22nd – November 27th (Sun-Fri)

After the positive feedback from the participants of the 50th Anniversary Tour and Le Tour 2 we have decided to do another Le Tour de BSA , this time taking in some of the other great parts of our State that have equally great towns and roads for us to explore and visit on our bikes. The tour will follow similar arrangements to the first two tours in that you will need to book for the tour on Try Booking via the link from the club calendar on the club website (www.bsa.asn.au) it is a live booking that will require the payment of the full Tour fee. Once you have entered the tour you will then need to arrange and book your overnight accommodation for the overnight stops.

The committee has decided to limited number of entries to 50 Bikes and will subsidise this event to make it more available to all members and as such is **only available to current financial BSAMOA members and their partners.**

I have chosen the overnight stops to be in towns with suitable facilities and accommodation for our needs, and have been able to get some of the accommodation venues to offer to give us a group a discount. So, if booking the venues mentioned – it would be best to contact them directly and mention you are part of the BSAMOA group and ask if a discount applies, also some have reserved cabins in advance for tour participants. The listed accommodation providers are only suggested venues and everyone will need to choose and book their own accommodation. Can I suggest that you have discussion with your fellow tour participants to share the spare space and cost of the accommodation which will also mean more of us can stay in the suggested venues. ie. Multi room cabins in Holiday parks .

The Route and Overnight Stops.

Sunday 22/11/2026 Day 1 The tour will leave from Healesville, meet 9.30 to leave 10.30 am – Thanks to a generous, long standing club member, kindly offering his property close by for participants who need to leave cars and trailers for the rally week. We will be arranging a luggage drop the day before so we can minimise the numbers of members who need to leave vehicles at Healesville.

The route for day one will take us to Kinglake West, Seymour, Nagambie and Murchison and then Euroa. Distance Approx. 213 Km The overnight stop for Day 1 is the Euroa Caravan Park in Euroa.

The Euroa Caravan Park in Euroa is very close to our dinner venue and accommodation can be booked direct on **Ph. 57 952160**

Dinner will be at the Seven Creeks Hotel (included in Tour entry)

There are other Accommodation options (Motels) nearby in Euroa within walking distance to our dinner venue.

Monday 23/11/2026 Day 2

The Route for day 2 will take us from Euroa, up into the hills used by the infamous Bushrangers of the early days of our state, through the farming land of the Northern east country and onto the mighty Murray River, even spreading a little Victorian Beezer oil onto some of our neighbouring state's roads before returning to Victoria and our overnight stop in Rutherglen.

Distance Approx. 209 Km. The overnight stop for Day 2 is Rutherglen. The Rutherglen Holiday Park (Big 4) is our accommodation suggested option for day 2 and we are having dinner catered there. **Ph 02 60328577**

There are other Accommodation options (Motels) nearby in Rutherglen within walking distance to our dinner venue.

Dinner will be a Catered On-site Wood fire Pizza Night at the Rutherglen Holiday Park **(included in Tour entry)**

Tuesday 24/11/2026 Day 3

Day 3 - You will cross back over the Mighty Murray and follow it through Albury and onto Lake Hume . We will skirt around the shores of the lake and onto old Tallangatta and then Kiewa. We then will take in some of the North east countryside and ending up in the old gold town of Beechworth for our 2 night stop-over. Distance Approx. 207 Km.

We will be based at the Beechworth Lake Sambell Caravan Park, 20 Peach Drive Beechworth, Ph 57 28 1421. Beechworth has lots of accommodation options but it is quite spread out.

Dinner for Tuesday Night will be a Mexican Night to be held at the Lake Sambell Holiday Park in Beechworth and proceeded by a happy hour with nibbles and a free drink or 2 to make the tall tales all that much taller. (included in Tour entry)

Wednesday 25/11/2026 Day 4

Today is a local day around the Beechworth area with a short day ride to take in some of the area's points of interest and a visits to the old "Gold Towns " of Chilton and Yackandandah, a distance of approx. 86 Km. We will have a lunch in Yackandandah with a voucher to the Local speciality Pie shop (included in the tour entry) before returning to Beechworth

If you prefer a less active day you can just meet us at Yackandandah for lunch, approx. 22 Km from Beechworth.

Wednesday night is a free night with **no organised dinner**, as we will have had lunch together in Yackandandah. There are many, varied choices for dinner/take away in Beechworth.

Thursday 26/11/2024 Day 5

Day 5 will find the Beezers touring via a somewhat indirect route, but through some great roads to Glenrowan and then up the King Valley to Whitfield, and then over the hills and onto Mansfield, our final overnight stop. Distance of approx. 223 Km.

The High Country Holiday Park Ph 5775 2705 in Mansfield will be our final accommodation base and is a 10 min walk to dinner .

Dinner for our Final evening (Thursday) will be at the Commercial Hotel in Mansfield . (included in the tour entry)

Friday 22/11/2024 Day 6

Mansfield – Murton – Highlands – Yea .

The Last day of our Tour will take us past and over Lake Eildon at Bonne Doon and onto Murton then up into the hills that were blackened with bushfire less than a year ago, you will see the lingering evidence of the fires but also realise how the countryside bounces back into life (unlike some of the manmade structures) .

We will a regroup for a final Farwell to our Tour , including a light lunch and a drink at a convenient but yet to be finalised location in Yea **(included in the tour entry)** about 11.30 am before different groups may choose their best way home or head back to the starting point at Healsville.

Distance of approx.. 110 Km to Yea

Distance of approx.. 70 Km Yea to Healesville

To Be a part of our BSAMOA Club Touring Rally (Le Tour de BSA 3-Trois) you will need to book and pay for the **entry fee \$175.00 PP (Your committee has decided to hold the price at the same price as Le Tour Deux, the only thing that has not increased in price in the last 2 years I suspect!!!!)** – covers cost of 4 evening meals plus 2 lunches, a tour shirt, back-up vehicle and luggage van costs .

Book for the Le Tour de BSA 3 Trois on Try Booking via the link from the club calendar on the club website (www.bsa.asn.au)

You will also need to arrange your own accommodation for the tour stops, can I suggest if you are going to attend that you don't leave the accommodation booking to the last minute! Many of the Accommodation businesses have said that although they have vacancies now, November is a busy time - so book early!

If using the suggested accommodation venues please contact them directly as some have reserved cabins for us (BSAMOA) and some offered a small discount - all have prior notice of our group.
